

Business Management Higher

Higher Business Management builds on the skills, knowledge and understanding gained at National 5 and can act as an entry to the study of business.

This Higher aims to enable learners to develop and extend:

- knowledge and understanding of the ways in which society relies on businesses and other organisations to satisfy its needs
- understanding of enterprising skills and attributes
- understanding of business-related financial matters
- an understanding of how businesses and other organisations improve overall performance and effectiveness
- knowledge and understanding of the main effects that external influences have on large organisations

You will study 3 units:

- Business Management: Understanding Business
- Business Management: Management of People and Finance
- Business Management: Management of Marketing and Operations



Moving on

Higher Business Management is a suitable preparation for entry to higher education courses in Business or further study in other academic or vocational subjects.

How will I be assessed?

A combination of internal assessment on completion of units, an external Business Management question paper and a business-related assignment.

How and where will I study?

6 periods per school week are allocated. 4 with lecturer, 2 periods for self-study/revision.

Entry requirements

Nat 5 Business Management or similar.
