



Safe Conduct and the Coronavirus

At West Highland College UHI, we firmly believe that health and wellbeing of our staff, students and visitors is paramount. We have identified that our priority must be to make sure that our campuses are as safe as possible whilst minimising the risk to everyone on site. This will continue to be in line with relevant Government guidelines. In the event of an outbreak of confirmed coronavirus, the college will support and share relevant information as per the public health Test and Protect measures.

Government guidance (10th July 2020) states that “Universities and colleges can have a phased return with a blended model of remote learning (online classroom) and limited on campus learning (practical courses) where this is a priority.”

Only those staff and students who have prior agreement will be able to attend a centre at designated times on allocated days.

Priority agreement will be given to:

- Students enrolled on practical courses requiring specialist workshops and areas for delivery.
- Staff who deliver these practical courses and staff who are required for core support functions of college work.
- Students who cannot study effectively online from home.
- Staff who cannot work effectively online from home.

Standard expectations whilst on and around our campuses

To be able to keep everyone safe we must **all** agree to some simple expectations about conduct in and around our campus for us all to follow. Anyone found not to be following our guidelines can be asked to leave site.

- You must stay at home if you or anyone in your household have any symptoms of COVID 19.
- You must adhere to all existing and new signage, and ways to move within the buildings across all campuses. See signage examples on next page.
- You must use hand washing / hand sanitising stations and cleaning materials throughout campus, as directed.
- You must maintain appropriate distancing within buildings, circulation spaces and within classrooms.
- You will need to queue whilst maintaining social distancing when entering or leaving campus or classrooms. Please be patient and cooperate with each other.
- You must wear face coverings, as directed by the Scottish Government, in all communal spaces.
- You must maintain appropriate social distancing when using the limited seating in eating areas.
- You must clean down your workspace and equipment using sanitising wipes which will be available. **Everyone** using a workspace is expected to clean it down when they have finished. This also applies to eating areas.
- There will be dedicated pick-up / drop-off points for collection and return of equipment.

Please do not enter if you or any of your household have any COVID-19 symptoms

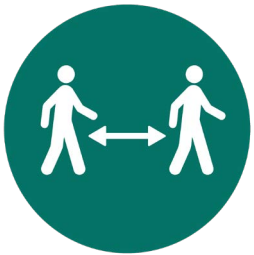
This also applies if you are living with someone who has developed any new symptoms. Please stay at home, get tested and isolate as per the guidelines.
