What skills will you gain?

This course will help you appreciate and understand some of the key skills required to succeed at college/university and is for anyone considering a programme of study at a higher education college and/or university.

This has been designed to ease transition into higher education and increase your knowledge and understanding of skills that will be useful to you in higher education.

You will learn how to handle personal finance, look at research skills, improve your use of various IT applications and also look at valuable skills in communication and mental health & wellbeing

Entry requirements?

This course requires a higher level of written work, you must demonstrate an appropriate standard of written communication.

You must be working at SCQF level 6 or above. Entry to this course requires a satisfactory reference.

How and where will I study?

This programme of study is available through the Highland Council Virtual School timetable and is delivered via Google hangouts or Brightspace, a virtual learning platform. Delivery starts in June.
