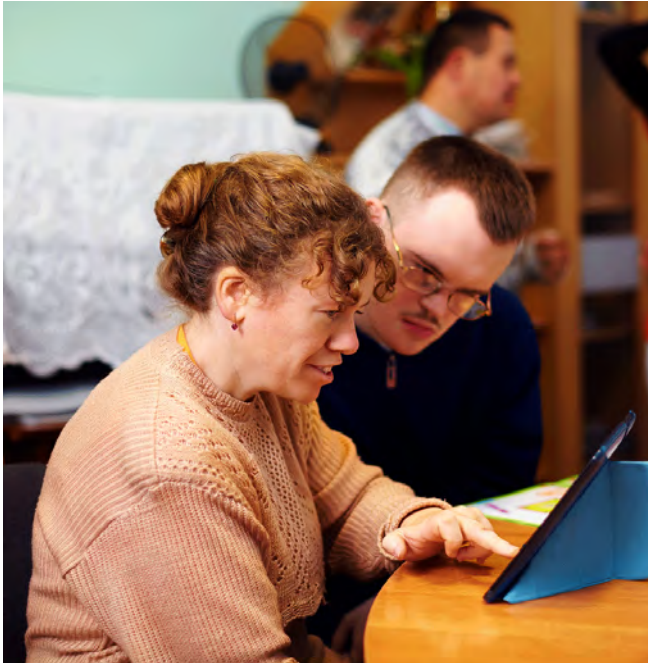


Supported Learning Programme



What skills will you gain?

Our Supported Learning Programme is for students with learning disabilities and those with specific additional support needs.
